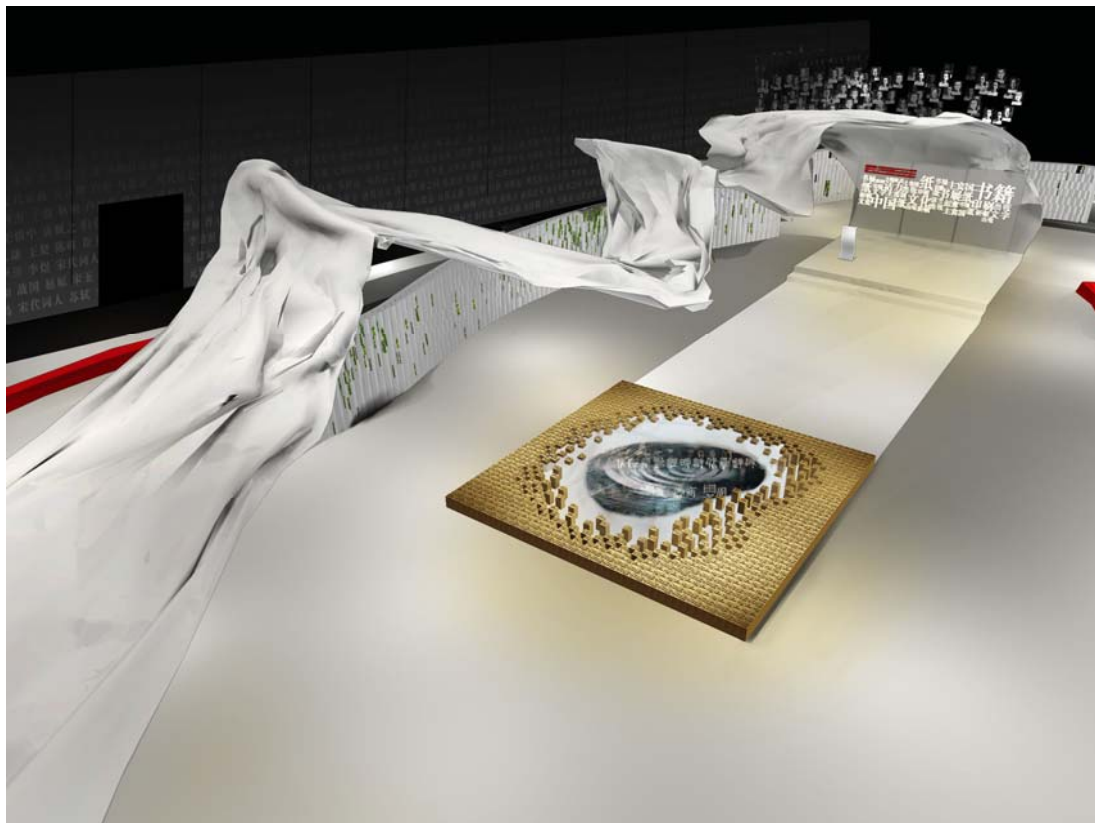


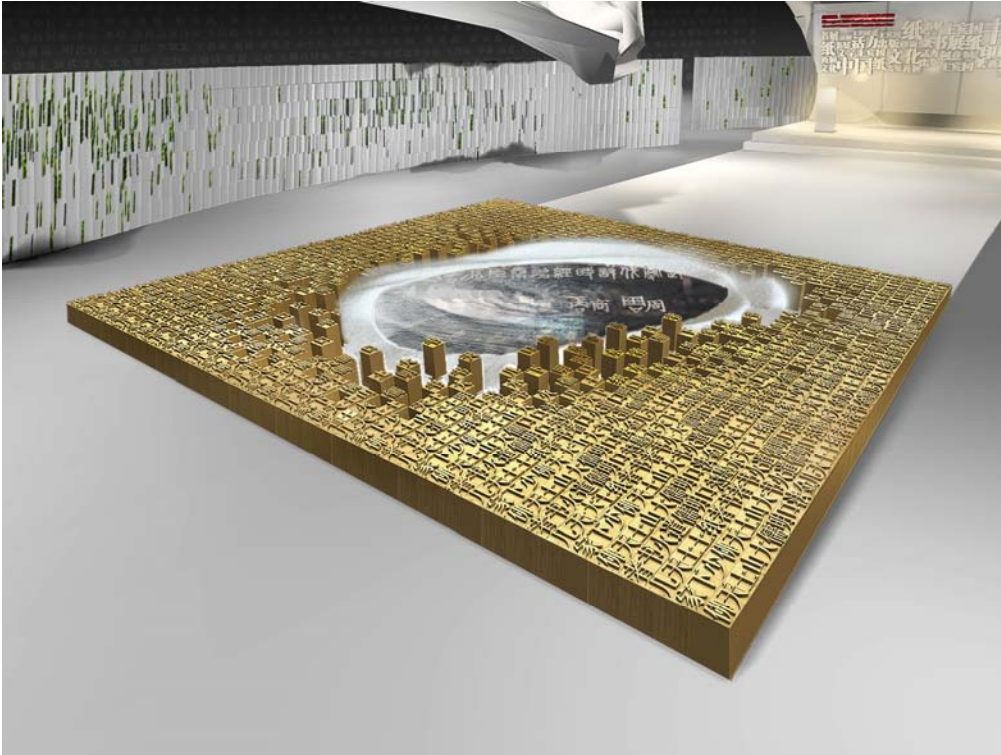
A drop of ink: The image of a drop of ink is projected onto the water surface while at the same time a water drop falls into the water. 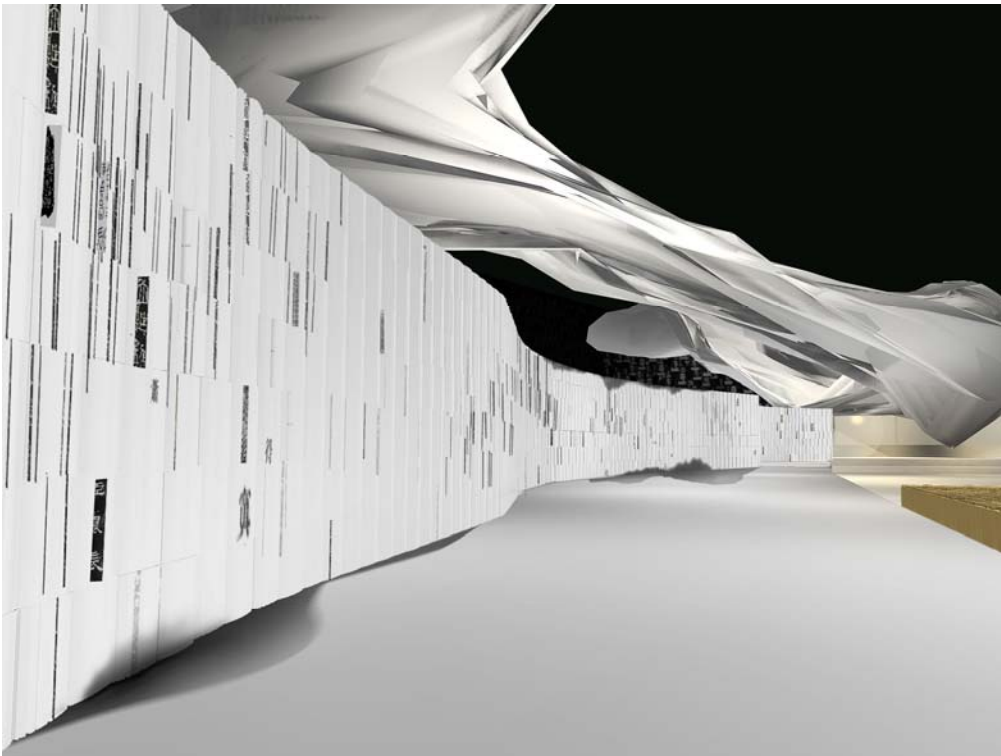

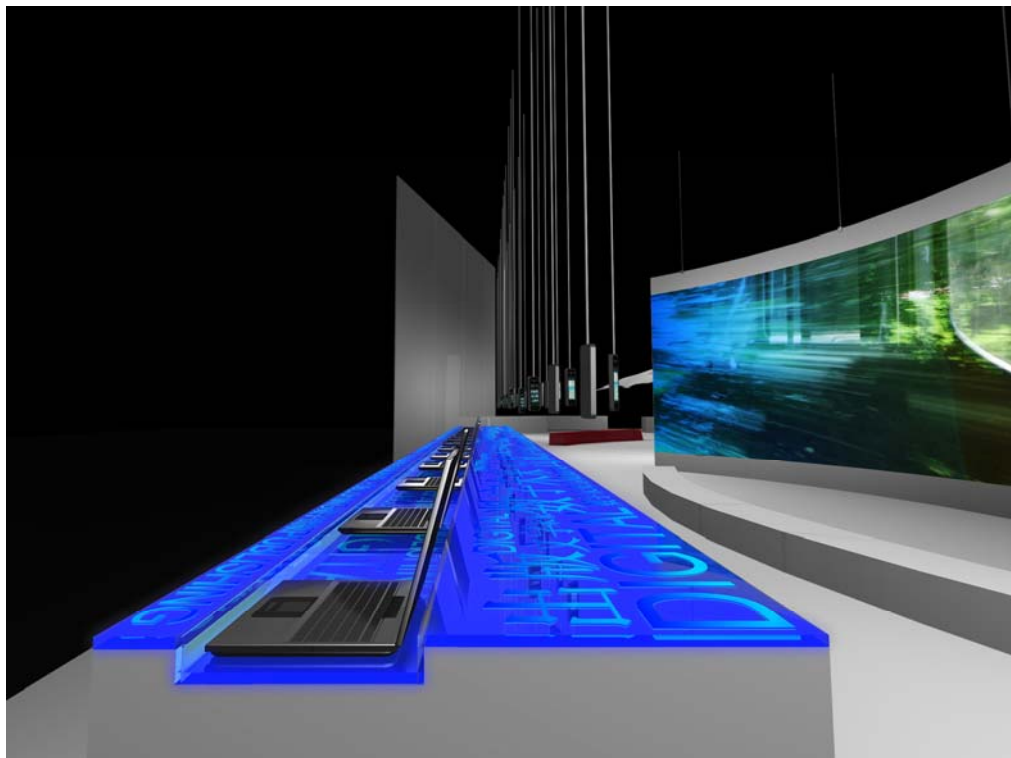
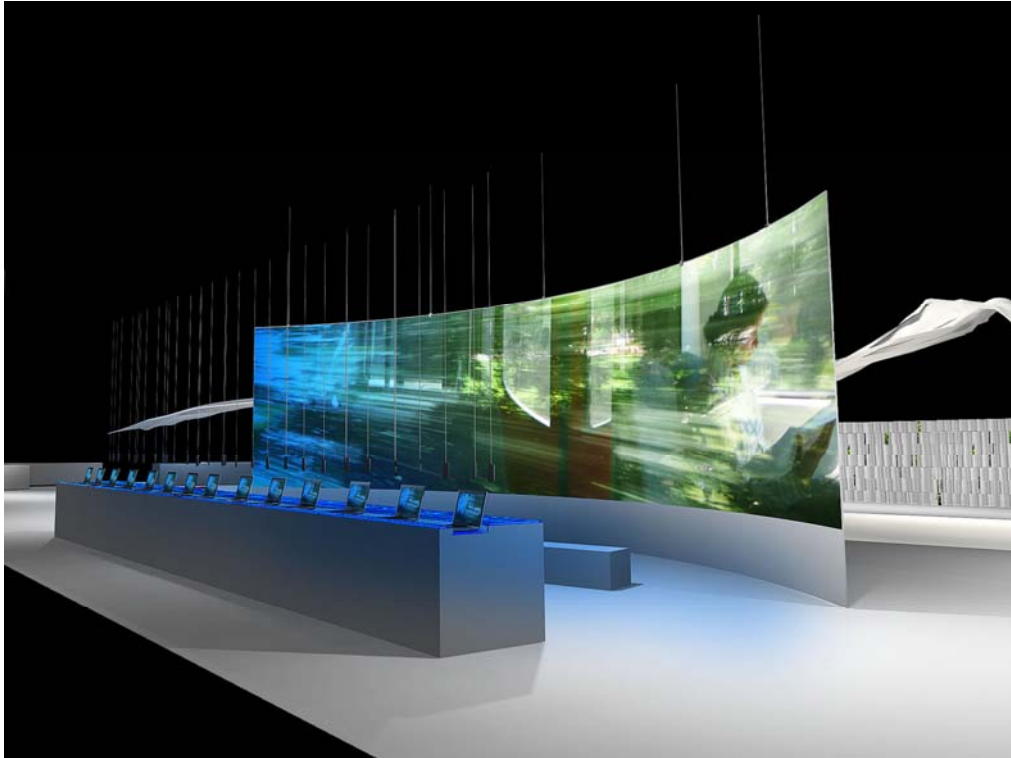
