Terms and Conditions for the Supply of Parking Permits

1. Order Placement

(1) Orders for parking permits shall be placed by submitting a completely filled out form for ordering parking permits applying to the event in question. Oral or telephone orders shall be confirmed by exhibitors in writing.

(2) Orders shall be signed by the applicant. One copy only thereof shall be submitted to Fraport AG

hereinafter referred to as "Fraport", and must be received by Fraport no later than six (6) weeks prior to the opening of the event involved, otherwise no liability for their timely completion will be assumed. Orders submitted by third parties (stand builders) shall be accepted and completed only if they bear the exhibitor's signature and company seal or the third party involved has been granted power of attorney to sign same on behalf of the exhibitor.

(3) Orders received by Fraport at a later date shall be disregarded when parking permits are assigned. No confirmations of receipt of orders for parking permits will be sent. Parking permits shall be sent to exhibitors no later than two (2) weeks prior to the opening of the event in question. Further details may be clarified by contacting Fraport directly.

2. Description of Items to be Provided

(1) Fraport shall have the requested parking permits made available, based on exhibitors' orders. Parking permits entitle bearers to park vehicles on the parking spaces stated thereon.

(2) The information supplied will already have been printed on parking permits. The field la-

belled "Stand Telefon" ("Stand telephone") will have to be filled out. Parking permits may be issued on a space-available basis and for the full duration of the event in question only. Parking permits for the nearest available car park shall be automatically issued by stand number and stand size. Exhibitors have no general entitlement to request parking permits for certain parking spaces. Parking trucks, vans, trailers, containers, buses or house trailers on reserved parking spaces is prohibited.

(3) Parking permits shall be stuck on a readily visible location on vehicles' windshields at all times during parking procedures. Vehicles lacking readily visible parking permits and vehicles parked on other than the assigned parking spaces shall be towed away without prior notice. Parking permits will be confiscated if the above regulations are not observed. The respective Parking Regulation (Parkplatzbenutzungsordnung) shall apply. Only original parking permits shall be valid. Messe Frankfurt Venue GmbH & Co. KG reserves the right to prosecute anyone who duplicates parking permits, under Section 265a of the German Criminal Code (StGB). In such cases, both the original parking permit and the copies will be confiscated and the vehicle banned from the grounds. A fine will also be imposed.

(4) In order to be able to provide exhibitors with rapid assistance in the event that problems arise, Fraport shall operate an emergency standby service, whose location and telephone number may be obtained from the hall inspector's office, on all days of the event in question.

3. Invoicing

(1) Invoices shall be due and payable upon receipt. Messe Frankfurt Venue GmbH & Co. KG shall be entitled to invoice ordered items in advance.

(2) The charges listed in our currently valid price list shall be binding upon both parties hereto. Any services that do not appear in the list are not included in the charges stated

therein and shall, where applicable, be invoiced separately.

(3) Offsetting counterclaims against invoiced amounts and deductions of any kind from invoiced amounts are prohibited.

(4) Complaints regarding failure to deliver ordered items or missing items must be received by Fraport no later than the first day of the trade fair. Any complaints received thereafter shall be disregarded.

(5) Exhibitors shall not be entitled to demand replacements for lost parking permits.

4. Cancellations by the Ordering Party

In the event that an order is to be cancelled by the exhibitor, Fraport shall be notified thereof in writing no later than three (3) weeks prior to the opening of the event involved, reckoned from date of receipt. Cancellations can be accepted at later dates only if the respective service(s) have not yet been provided or provision thereof has not yet commenced. The same shall apply analogously to any changes to ordered services.

5. General Conditions

(1) Both parties to the agreement accept these terms and conditions as integral parts of the agreement binding upon both parties.

(2) If individual provisions of this agreement are invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining provisions. In such a case, both contracting parties undertake to replace the invalid provisions by valid provisions that approach the commercial purpose intended by the invalid provisions as closely as possible.

(3) Both parties to the agreement explicitly agree to accept Frankfurt am Main as the place of performance and place of jurisdiction for any and all claims and disputes arising from this agreement.
